



Wado Kai Student Development Scholarship

The Wado Kai Student Development Fund offers two annual scholarships of \$1000 to two applicants who best demonstrate well roundedness in academic accomplishments, extracurricular activities, and karate achievements. A third scholarship of \$1000 is awarded as part of the Jean Foster Memorial Fund.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. The **applicant** must be an active member of the Shintani Wado Kai Karate Federation (SWKKF) in the year that they are applying. The applicant will either be a student or a parent/guardian of a student:
 - a. If the applicant is the student, he/she will be judged on their academic accomplishments, extracurricular activities and karate achievements.
 - b. If the applicant is a parent/guardian of the student, the application will be judged on:
 - i. The student's academic accomplishments and extracurricular activities
 - ii. The parent/guardian's karate achievements
2. The **student** must be applying to or continuing in a post-secondary institution such as university, college, technological institute, teacher's college, etc.
3. The student's academic success (e.g. grades) must be sufficient to allow admittance into the post-secondary institution or continuance from one year to the next. ****Note:** Proof of acceptance or continuance within the institute will be required before the scholarship is released.
4. **All sections** of the application must be received by **June 30, 2020**. Email submissions will be accepted until midnight and mailed submissions must be postmarked by the deadline.

****The SWKKF Scholarship Committee is aware of the challenges related to COVID-19 particularly its impact to academic programs and extracurricular activities. Applications will be assessed with these considerations in mind.**

Completing an Application:

1. Applications are judged on three (3) equally weighted categories (academic success, extra-curricular activities, and karate achievements) so applicants should detail all relevant skills and accomplishments. Use the appropriate forms provided.
2. Write legibly or use a computer to fill out all sections of the application.
3. Refer to the checklist at the end of the application to ensure all documents are submitted.
Incomplete applications will be not be submitted to the committee for review.
