This is an opportunity for black belts to participate and showcase their ability to demonstrate bunkai within Shintani Karate katas (may include Shindo katas).

COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

- Competitors must be a Black Belt (Yodan-up)
- Competitors can utilize one or more opponents of any ranks
- Competitors will demonstrate and explain how to execute **3 to 5 Bunkai Techniques** from any karate or shindo Kata that are within the Shintani Wado Kai Karate Federation guidelines
- Complete presentation time is 6 minutes or less.

JUDGING CRITERIA

The judging criteria will be based on form, speed, power, explanation and practicality.

METHOD OF SCORING

Centre Referee will determine the range of scoring.
